JOHANNA stumbled bumped AT a PREIUM at the start, slowly regained stride around the first turn, three wide pursuit of runaway leader leaving the quarter pole, chased on through the final sixteenth, second best. MASKEDANDMUMMED away in good order, rated kindly off the pace threewide down the backside, no match from the quarter pole, stayed on willingly for the show. ORANGE CANYON bumped at the start, saved ground down the backside, put to task leaving the quarter pole, had no late impact.
