By subscription of \$150 each, which shall accompany the nomination, Closed Thursday July 16, 2026 With 15 or by supplementary nomination of \$1,500 each (non-Golden State Series eligible horses, \$25,000 to supplement -- which will make that horse eligible to all future Golden State Series Stakes) by closing time of entries. All horses to pay \$2,250 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed, of which \$85,500 to first, \$28,500 to second, \$18,000 to third, \$9,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth, \$3,000 to sixth. SHE'S NO QUANT got bumped between rivals at the start, stalked the speed from between runners, brushed with DONTTELLMEWHATTODO at the half-mile pole, got crowded and lost a bit of ground into the turn, came under a ride past the five-sixteenths pole, was closest in pursuit turning for home, loomed boldly in upper stretch, drew alongside MOHAVEN shortly after, seized control outside the sixteenth pole and maintained command over MOHAVEN to the wire. MOHAVEN dueled briefly from outside then cleared to take control in the early going, showed the way along the inside through the turn, given her cue at the top of the stretch, collared by SHE'S NO QUANT midstretch, relinquished the lead into the final sixteenth and stayed on well for a clear second. TAPATIA MIA was antsy in the gate, lacked early speed, traveled two to three wide on the turn, angled five wide leaving the bend, produced a mild rally and bested the others. TAKING A JOY RIDE bumped with inner rival at the nine-sixteenths pole, chased three deep into the turn, remained off the rail to the stretch and could not summon the needed rally. LINO'S ANGEL tracked on the inside out of range, moved into the two path then came back to the rail around the bend, cut the corner into the stretch and lacked further response. LYNDEE'S DREAM broke in and bumped, got crowded in the early going, got crowded again up the backstretch then bumped with TAKING A JOY RIDE at the nine-sixteenths pole, ridden along two, three, then four wide on the turn and failed to menace. LIBERATION stalked three deep early, cut to the two path entering the turn to bother the winner, found the rail past the five-sixteenths pole and faded down the lane. TROISIEME ETOILE brushed leaving the gate, traveled near the back off the rail then three deep into the turn, moved to the four path around the bend and came up empty in the stretch run. DONTTELLMEWHATTODO was antsy in the gate, dueled briefly for the lead then chased after the pacesetter inside a pair of rivals, brushed with the winner at the half-mile pole, got put in tight approaching the five-sixteenths marker, dropped back around the turn and tired.
