GENERAL JIMBO showed no early interest and was near the back early, moved off the rail going into the first turn, stayed out about three-wide down the backstretch, dropped to the rail through the far turn, but was unable to improve. FORDY G broke well and dueled with COME ON AMP through the early stages, took a slight lead late on the backstretch, fought back when CHRISTINE'S JACK made a bid late on the far turn, but was outkicked in the stretch, while saving the place. COME ON AMP pressed the early pace in the two-path, ceded the front approaching the quarter pole, then went evenly from that point. NAVAL HARBOR was devoid of speed, dropped far behind, and was distanced. CHRISTINE'S JACK settled well off the early pace in the middle of the pack, moved up three-wide to bid for the lead through the far turn, drifted out a bit on the last bend but kept momentum and drew clear in the late stages.
