AIN'T NO SISSY settled well off the pace but kept to the inside, made a forward move through the last turn, came out to the three-path for the stretch run, battled two rivals to the inside and was just up in the last jumps. DOMINATE tracked the pace while racing two to three wide, took command nearing the quarter pole, opened clear, then was confronted by two rivals, one inside and one outside, battled gamely through the stretch before yielding grudgingly in a three-way finish. STOP AND A TRES saved ground throughout, remained between rivals in a prolonged stretch duel, finished courageously despite racing in tight quarters, but was narrowly denied. CORN POP was always close up, then was outkicked in the late stages. TAVERNELLE secured forward position while racing three wide, took command passing the finish line the first time, then weakened on the final turn. BLACKJACK AND BEER trailed the field early, was distanced after a half-mile, stopped, was eased, galloped to the finish line, and walked off.
