1 $\frac{1}{16}$ MILES. (1.431) TOMBOYS. Purse \$75,000 (includes \$26,250 OTF – Ohio Thoroughbred Fund) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD, REGISTERED OHIO FOALS. By subscription of \$50 each, which shall accompany the nomination. \$263 due at time of entry and \$487 additional to start, which shall be due at noon, day of the race. \$75,000 Guaranteed (Includes \$26,250 OTF), of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth; 2% to sixth. Weight 122 lbs. non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over, allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of three races other than maiden, claiming, optional or starter allowed 4 lbs.; Two races other than maiden, claiming, optional or starter allowed, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) horses on Turf with preference to start given to those who have accumulated the highest career earnings in 2025–2026. Should this race be determined to run on the dirt the distance will remain the same with (14) Starters. Failure to draw in cancels all fees. Lasix is not permitted. Nominations closed Wednesday, August 19, 2026 with 15 nominations. (If transferred to the Main Track, this race will be run at One Mile and a Sixteenth.) (ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED FOR TURF).

CAST YOUR SPELL stalked the moderate pace to the backstretch, given her cue into the far turn, vied for the lead at the quarter pole then took command to upper stretch, kicked clear into the lane, kept to task under steady urging into the final sixteenth then was ridden out late to win as much the best. RYKA settled in the second flight to begin, asked three wide at the quarter marker, was no match for the winner into the stretch but bested the rest for second. NO NAPPING settled outside of rivals early, roused four wide into the far turn, needed more into the stretch but stayed on late and got up for third. ECHO VALLEY bobbed then lost her path at the start and was last away from the gate, settled while saving ground, advanced between foes into the far turn, coaxed two to three wide to upper stretch, couldn't muster the needed final response and was outfinished for third. SWEET KYLIE forwardly placed while saving ground, tracked the moderate pace to the half-mile marker, chased from the inside to the quarter pole then weakened in the stretch. R U ENTICED broke in at the start and crowded an inner rival, settled while saving ground to the backstretch, outrun into the far turn and failed to threaten late. BOKEH unhurried to the backstretch, gained ground two to three wide and between rivals along the far turn, couldn't sustain that bid into upper stretch and faltered in the drive. BASIS POINT vied for the early lead then took command, set a moderate pace to the half-mile marker, came under pressure into the far turn then was overtaken into upper stretch, chased to the furlong grounds then tired in the late stages.
