WHITE MOUNTAIN stalked the pace three and four wide early, bid into the lane then dug in late as a rival charged inside and just held. EZ FITZ moved up inside to challenge going to the far turn, dug in through the lane and just missed late. JABRAN press the pace three or four wide to come five wide into the lane and wore down late to lost position. SWEET MOTHER MARY saved ground and could not threaten late. AXEL STEEL was on the pace about the two to three path early, came out four wide in the far turn and weakened in the drive. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and it was re-timed using video technology to obtain the most accurate final time available.
