CAROLINE ST. BEAT well placed while in the second flight early on, saved all of the ground heading to the second turn, tipped out nearing the top of the lane and set down for the drive, wore down the game runner-up approaching the final sixteenth and edged away late. GLACIUS (GB) took early command, made all of the pace while well handled to the second turn, met the bid of CAROLINE ST. BEAT into the stretch, grudgingly gave way to the winner in the final sixteenth and was a clear second. GO GREY settled outside of rivals to begin, trailed approaching the far turn, bid three to four wide and between foes into the stretch, closed willingly in the lane and got up in time for third. NIL BUA GANDUA tracked the early pace from the second flight and outside of rivals, coaxed three wide into the second turn, outkicked to upper stretch, flattened out in the drive and just missed for third. CAUSEWAY (IRE) off a step slow then allowed to settle, moved up between rivals along the backstretch then caught in tight approaching the far turn, steered to the five path nearing the top of the stretch, lacked a final response and finished evenly. FANCY SAILOR settled between rivals early on, lost position approaching the second turn, coaxed from the six path to upper stretch, needed more to the final sixteenth and offered a mild late rally. ROYAL CAUSEWAY unhurried while saving ground, advanced along the inside approaching the second turn, kept an inside path to the stretch, got caught in traffic approaching the furlong grounds, lacked room to the final sixteenth and failed to threaten late. GOSTAM (GER) forwardly placed to the first turn, stalked the pace three wide into the backstretch, well placed to the second turn, got outkicked to upper stretch, needed more in the drive and weakened. VERSAILLES ROAD prominent early, tracked the pace between rivals into the backstretch, chased two wide and between foes into the second turn, dropped back nearing the top of the lane, lacked a final response and gave way. ROYAL GUARD shuffled back a bit away from the start, settled in the second flight to begin then clipped heels and checked into the first turn, coaxed between runners into the second turn, lacked the needed response to upper stretch, was eased through the lane and walked off.
