SOMERSET WEST allowed to settle, coaxed outside of rivals along the turn, mounted a four then five wide rally to the stretch, was full of run to the final sixteenth and determinedly got up in time. LION LAKE (IRE) settled in the second flight and between runners, tracked to the half-mile marker then raced in traffic to upper stretch, found a seam three to four wide into the final sixteenth, vied late and was outfinished for the win, while earning the nod for the place at the wire. GROUND SUPPORT well placed while saving ground to the turn, chased from the inside to upper stretch, battled from the rail into the final furlong, fought gamely to deep stretch and was outfinished for the win and place, while holding for the show. SAPPHIRE BEACH (IRE) prominent early, attended to the solid pace outside of LIGHT WON UP, dueled on even terms with that rival into upper stretch, battled between foes into the final sixteenth and was outfinished in deep stretch, bled. LIGHT WON UP sent for the early lead, showed good speed and dictated terms from the inside heading into the turn, dug in when challenged into upper stretch, battled between foes into the final furlong, was caught in tight between runners into deep stretch and yielded late. CY FAIR settled while saving ground to the turn, kept an inside path approaching the top of the lane, shifted to the two path for the stretch, lacked room to the final sixteenth, angled out in deep stretch but could not offer the needed late response. QUIET STREET broke out at the start then allowed to settle, advanced from the inside to upper stretch, got caught behind a wall of runners to the final sixteenth, angled out in deep stretch but finished evenly. CADENZA close up to the early pace, tracked three wide into the turn, was well placed to the top of the lane, lacked the needed response into the final furlong and weakened late. FINAL ACCORD settled in the second flight and outside of runners, coaxed three then four wide nearing the half-mile marker, chased to upper stretch, couldn't find more in the drive and gave way. GREEN SENSE (IRE) crowded at the start and a step slow leaving the gate, settled in the two path to the turn, angled three then four wide to upper stretch and lacked a late finish. COCO CONNECT off slow, lacked early speed, trailed upper stretch, no factor. PERCY'S BAR settled in the second flight and between runners early on, was caught in tight and shuffled back approaching the turn, lost position into the bend, coaxed three wide to upper stretch, lacked a late response.
