7½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.272) RED EARTH H. Purse \$50,000 (plus \$20,000 OBP – Oklahoma Bred Program) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. ACCREDITED OKLAHOMA FOALS. No nomination fee. \$600 to pass the entry box. Starters to pay \$500 additional with \$50,000 guaranteed by Remington Park and an additional \$20,000 plus from the Oklahoma Bred Fund. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry for a fee of \$2,200, which qualifies to start. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of entry. High Weights Preferred, Then Highest Lifetime Earnings Will Be Used In Determining The Order Of Preference Of Horses with Equal Weights on the Scale. Earnings will be determined according to statistics provided by Equibase. This race will be limited to 12 starters. The guaranteed money and OBF funds to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Fees include a custom saddle towel that will be presented to each entrant. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. (If management deems it necessary to take this race off the Turf, it will be run at a distance of 1 Mile on the main track.).

EXCAPING THE BLUES stalked the early pace while inside on the backstretch and far turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and closed fast on the outside and drew away in the end. COUNTRY CAPER was angled out on the first turn sharply then settled for the run down the backstretch, raced three wide then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch and closed well in late stretch to be along for the place. STONEY BRICK ROAD bore in on the first turn and head hid heels clipped then vied for the lead while two wide, was in a long sustained drive but weakened in late stretch. C W PRIZE vied for the lead while three wide on the backstretch, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. WINTERS LION was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, moved out to be eight wide in upper stretch and made a late gain in the end. RED MOUNTAIN was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, was nine wide in upper stretch and passed tiring rivals in late stretch. GOOD SWIMMER bore out on the first turn then vied for the lead from the inside, was used up and gave way. CLASSY EMPIRE was allowed to settle then failed to menace. TAP THE DOT was allowed to settle in the early going while two wide then failed to menace in the stretch. NUMBER ONE DUDE was angled out on the first turn then was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn but was no threat. BIG MUCKITY bore out on the run down the backstretch to be five wide and vying for the lead on the far turn then gave way in the stretch. SONIC POSSE was in tight and clipped heels then stumbled badly on the first turn, chased the pace while two wide then stopped in the stretch. A steward's inquiry was held concerning the run into the first turn, After reviewing the film's, the steward's disqualified STONEY BRICK ROAD from third and was placed last for interference.
