

5 FURLONGS. (Turf) (.533) 4TH RUNNING OF THE CAPTIVA ISLAND. Purse \$75,000 FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, February 25. \$750 to enter. \$75,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes since September 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race since September 1, 4 lbs.;; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs) (Rail at 12 feet).

BLUE BAHIA was close-up inside from the start, awaited room just behind the leaders around the turn, had no choice but to go through a tight opening on the fence in upper stretch, squeezed her way through brushing GIRLS KNOW BEST aside under vigorous hand urging, and edged away from MORTICIA while flashed the whip late. MORTICIA sprinted up forwardly placed outside, stayed locked on to GIRLS KNOW BEST turning for home, reached a short lead widest of a trio passing the furlong marker, and was outfinished. JUST TALKIN settled in midpack early, swung out four wide approaching the stretch and finished with good energy outside the top two. JENNIFER LYNNETTE was slow into stride, lagged well back two wide around the turn, shifted out widest for the drive and made up ground belatedly while never a factor. JUMBY BAY bumped with PRETTY PERFECTION at the start, lacked speed inside to the turn, maneuvered out in upper stretch and was gaining late between horses. GOLDWOOD hustled along to stay close three wide to the turn, had the two-path turning for home behind the leading trio, was handled warily in traffic inside the last furlong and lost position late. ALWAYS THINKING broke slowly, trailed inside to the stretch, and offered only a mild late response outside. GIRLS KNOW BEST sprinted clear early, came under fire from both flanks straightening away for the drive in the two-path, got brushed and shouldered aside as BLUE BAHIA muscled through passing the eighth-pole, and gave way. PRETTY PERFECTION bumped with JUMBY BAY at the start, went along in tight quarters between foes up the backstretch, cut the corner wanting for room off the turn, came off the inside still lacking clearance and was never fully set down.
