INNER TURF FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each which should
 accompany the nomination. \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not
 originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be
 made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided 60% to the owner of the winner,
 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining
 finishers. Weights, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$150,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf in 2017-18 allowed
 2 lbs.; of such a race in 2017-18 or \$60,000 twice at a mile or over since September 1, 2017 allowed 4 lbs.;
 of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 6 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or
 state bred allowance at a mile or over since Septemeber 1, 2017 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to
 the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main
 Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading under review by the
 Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, April 21, 2018 with 28 Nominations. (Rail at 27 feet).

ROBERT BRUCE (CHI) tracked the pace in hand along the inside loosely behind the cover of the leader, got roused spinning just of the inside for home into the clear, rallied through a seam that enlarged and split foes through the now loosened seam a furlong out to take command, dug in under a drive with good energy to prevail kept to task. SPRING QUALITY forwardly placed in the two path, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths applying pressure to the leader for the initial time, swung three wide into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors chasing the winner home. LUCULLAN saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. TICONDEROGA saved grd in pursuit from mid pack, remained patiently handled until roused cutting the corner into upper stretch, was in behind the leader awaiting ROBERT BRUCE to clear outside, tipped out to the two path a furlong from home and offered up a mild bid. SILVERWAVE (FR) three wide through the first turn, settled three wide in the clear just off the pace down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and weakened in the late stages. MANITOULIN bumped twice at the start by SMALL BEAR who broke inwards and in turn bumped MARKITOFF and squeezed that rival back, raced three wide throughout coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch and failed to quicken. BLACKTYPE (FR) established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, came under coaxing at that juncture, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was displaced a furlong from home, weakened in the late stages. MARKITOFF got bumped twice at the start by MANITOULIN due to pressure from SMALL BEAR and was squeezed back, saved ground through the first turn, got forced to steady off the heels briefly of TICONDEROGA seven furlongs from home as that rival briefly went to tuck in front, tipped out three to four wide down the backstretch, came under coaxing three wide three furlongs from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. SMALL BEAR broke in at the start bumping MANITOULIN into MARKITOFF twice before while causing the pressure that squeezed back that rival, raced three wide forwardly placed early on before easing back to tracked three to four wide from near the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened.
