NOTIS THE JEWELL settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail through the stretch the first time, continued to bide her time behind the early pacesetters into the backstretch, tipped four wide for clear sailing in the run to the final turn, rallied strongly five wide through the turn, and closed with a rush five wide in the drive, assuming command in deep stretch and proving best. GOOD LUCK TO YOU away well and tracked the leader through the stretch the first time while racing two out from the rail, assumed control entering the final turn and quickly opened up a clear advantage, maintained a clear lead into the stretch, but was no match for the winner in deep stretch, but proved clearly second best. YUKON BELLE unhurried early while dropping back to trail, advanced three wide midway down the backstretch, rallied four wide through the final turn, was unable to keep tabs on the winner leaving the turn, and finished two wide in the drive to be up for a share. TOUCHING PROMISE broke sharply and tracked the leader from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and finished from along the rail in the stretch drive while unable to mount a late bid. CURLISH FIGURE stalked the leaders into the stretch the first time while saving ground along the inside, maintained a stalking trip in the run down the backstretch, rallied two out from the rail entering the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response while finishing two wide in the drive. PEACH PIKE raced to the lead one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, dictated the pace into the backstretch while racing just out from the rail, was overtaken entering the final turn, and had nothing to offer over the final furlong. DON'T TELL JUDY away alertly, was forced to check sharply when in tight quarters leaving the first turn, held a stalking trip from along the rail through the stretch the first time, dropped back to trail in the run to the final turn, and had nothing to offer over the final furlong.
