INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A GRADED SWEEPSTAKE IN 2018. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2017 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake in 2017-18 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred allowance races in 2018 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2018 allowed 8 lbs. UNI (GB) angled in sharply as the field was being sent off and running, made hard contact with the gate, leading the pilot to re-adjust in the right iron afterwards, sat reserved bringing up the back of the pack, at or near the inside route, was eased into two path midway on the backstretch, continued to bide time during the run around the second bend, was given her cue and proceeded to get sent to the outside heading into the stretch, completed the maneuver towards path five and took off in earnest, was worked inward with some right side stick work leaving the eighth pole to meet up with the second place finisher, got engaged in a spirited tussle with PRECIEUSE and gamely got up. PRECIEUSE (IRE) rated two wide during the initial stages, was let out a notch tipping into path four approaching the five-sixteenths pole, took off with a menacing burst of speed, maintained the momentum swinging slightly wider into the stretch to emerge at the eighth pole in possession of a narrow advantage, had the winner draw alongside a few jumps later, vied with vigour as the nemesis whittled away at the deficit, got caught in the shadow of the finish line. PAS DE SOUCIS (IRE) away without apparent mishap, established control in short order, was rated in path two setting the initial half on a loosely-contested lead, came under siege late on the second bend, moved onto the inside route when asked for more at the head of the stretch, relinquished, but held on well thereafter to salvage the show. ON LEAVE drafted behind the leader for the opening half, slid over to the rail and took it from the top of the far turn to the quarter pole, got tipped back to the outside prior to heading home, had clearance in path two to launch her rally, was given her cue and failed to fire appreciably. LIDO saved ground for nearly three-quarters, found enough space and slipped out as the third fraction was being finalized, got driven four wide during the initial portion of the stretch, straightened away and had no rally. BLETCHLEY (GB) strung out three wide on both turns, folded. THUNDERING SKY attended the pacesetter three wide for six furlongs and gave way.
