

1 1/8 MILES. (1.463 ) FLEET INDIAN S. Purse \$200,000 FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For Fillies not originally nominated, a supplement payment of \$2,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. ENGLISH SOUL broke alertly, vied mostly three wide and as the widest of a threesome for the top, got called upon as the dispute spilled over into the stretch, continued onward with gameness, beating two others in the final stride to post the score. TAKE CHARGE AUBREY sent over to the rail, fought as the innermost of three for control, was the first to get called upon for more, this occurring just shy of the quarter pole, was stubborn to the end only to get nipped in the last jump. SPLIT TIME cut over to the rail and rode it to midway on the backstretch, resumed its pursuit two wide and from between opponents afterwards, was maneuvered into path five for the drive home, finished with good energy down the center of the strip to grab the show. INDY'S LADY was moved over to the inside after making light contact with OUR SUPER NOVA right after the start, brought up the pack, one-paced, picked up interest when asked a bit at the five-sixteenths pole, straightened away six to seven wide a furlong or so later, rallied willingly for the final significant slice of the pot. CAUSE WE ARE LOYAL settled into the two path after the start, disputed the pace from between rivals until the general area of the sixteenth pole before weakening. OUR SUPER NOVA gently pinched in the shadow of the starting gate, swung three wide off the first turn, was out in path four taking up the chase on the next one, was under encouragement spinning into the stretch, rallied mildly. RACHEL'S BLUE MOON brushed at the break, raced three wide on both turns, under a drive on the second one, made it to the quarter pole and had no rally. HELD ACCOUNTABLE pursued the front runners two wide and made no impact. AUNT BABE towards the inside during the initial stages, was angled to the outside after the first fraction had been finalized, swung two wide onto the backstretch, was about as wide exiting it, arrived into the stretch and came up empty. PURELY LUCKY secured the pocket after lunging out as the field was sent on its way, stayed within range keeping watch on the contested pace, was let loose for the drive, appeared through by the sixteenth pole and was eased from that station onward, then proceeded to make it off the course without need of outside assistance. PAS DE DEUCE worked out a tuck shortly after stepping onto the clubhouse bend, was patiently tracking the front runners during the opening phases, got lightly hand urged after departing the backstretch, failed to respond when set down from the five-sixteenths pole to the end of the second bend, got taken in hand once into the stretch and retreated.
