PRESENTED BY TRUSTCO BANK PURSE \$150,000 (plus \$450 Starters Bonus) INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD FOALED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weights, Three year olds, 119 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Turf weights. Non-winners of \$60,000 on the turf in 2018 allowed 3 lbs.; of a sweepstake on the turf since October 1, 2017 allowed 5 lbs.; of three races on the turf allowed 7 lbs. Dirt Weights: Non-winners of a sweepstake on the dirt in 2017-18 allowed 3 lbs.; of three on the dirt in 2017-18 allowed 5 lbs.; of two races on the dirt allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. Closed Saturday, August 11, 2018 with 16 Nominations.

KHARAFSA moved in on the initial straightaway, saved ground on the first turn, settled near the back, was roused while moving from the hedge to the two path on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch then tipped out a path farther, rallied under a left-handed whip, closed strongly to get the lead at the furlong marker, shook clear into the final sixteenth and held under strong urging. OFFERING PLAN bumped twice with a foe at the start, rounded the first turn in the three path, settled towards the rear, was roused in the four path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch then leaned in a bit, rallied into the final furlong and closed well but missed while able to get the place. RAPT went around the first turn in the three path, settled at the back on the outside, started the far turn in the two path, angled to the four path under some urging at the five-sixteenths, came six wide into the stretch then drifted out under one crack of a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed shortly thereafter, rallied on the outside and finished with good energy to get the show. MORRISON was taken in hand early then rated in the two path on the first turn, followed the clear leader from second, moved closer late on the backstretch, was asked in the two path on the far turn, spun three wide into the stretch, took a brief lead approaching the furlong marker but quickly lost the advantage to the winner and weakened. TAPITATION raced between horses into the first turn, went around that bend in the three path, settled on the inside of a rival, was roused in the two path on the far turn, held a good striking position into upper stretch, chased while behind the leaders, was crowded for space near the furlong marker, moved out over heels late and was out-kicked. MO MAVERICK traveled around the first turn in the two path, was reserved in the front half of the field, moved closer late on the backstretch, chased in the three path on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, pursued the vanguard into the final furlong and tired. BLACK TIDE stormed to the lead nearing the seven-eighths pole, drew off in the two path on the first turn, set the clear pace, was asked in the two path on the far turn, raced under a strong hand ride in upper stretch, was put to the whip while losing the advantage coming to the furlong marker and gave way. THE JY settled along the hedge, was roused on the far turn, cut the corner in range of the leaders into upper stretch, was put to the whip near the three-sixteenths and came up empty. MEMORIES OF PETER bumped twice with an opponent at the start, rounded the first turn in the four path, settled on the outside, dropped back in the two path on the far turn and failed to respond. KING KREESA was hustled from the start then became rank when taken in hand after BLACK TIDE spurted to the lead nearing the seven-eighths, went three wide on the opening bend, settled on the far outside, dropped back under urging late on the backstretch, went four then five wide on the far turn, floated seven wide into the stretch and faltered.
