By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. TESORA settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, angled out six wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to close stoutly outside issuing a challenge through the final eighth, rolled by the leader inside the sixteenth marker to get up in the last jumps and prevail going away at the end. BROADWAY RUN pressed the pace three then two wide under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, took over command with three-sixteenths to go, dug in under a drive inching away inside the final furlong under growing late threat and was overtaken in the final strides to the finish and forced to settle for the place honors. CLOSER STILL (IRE) saved ground near the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch, closed well splitting foes a furlong out, then kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. FACTOROFWON broke out at the start bumping SOUPER STRIKING, prompted the pace four then three wide outside a pair, got set down angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive keeping on through to the finish but was outfinished in the late going. SOUPER STRIKING bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe breaking outwards, chased three to four wide from near the rear, got let out swinging six wide into upper stretch and offered up mild late foot. KITTEN'S COVERGIRL brushed the off side stall at the start, chased just off the inside from mid pack, tucked to the inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid before flattening out in the late stages. LADY SUEBEE chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled five wide for home, came up empty in the stretch. MIZ MAYHEM hustled from the gate, chased along the inside from just off the pace, came under urging three furlongs from home, swung three to four wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. MOMINOUE established the front under coaxing from the gate and crossed to show the way from the two path through swift splits under pressure from a pair from the get go, tucked inside through the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, yielded command three-sixteenths out and folded.
