By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination; \$600 to pass the entry box and an additional \$625 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,250 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 122 lbs. Older, 126. Weights: Non-winners of a Graded Stake at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2017-18 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming or starter at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 6 lbs. FIFTY FIVE away without apparent mishap, was strung out four wide on both turns, picked up interest when let out a notch at the three-eighths pole, scurrying into contention, was under a ride spinning about as wide into the stretch, maintained the momentum and charged to the top by the eighth pole, shifted a bit closer to the rail, kicked away to lead by as many three lengths, then had plenty left to fend off MUNCHIN MONEY's late bid. MUNCHKIN MONEY well held in path two during the initial stages, tipped into the path three in time for the run around the second bend, got cued up angling four wide into the three-sixteenths marker, rallied with belated energy to garner the place. LADY JOAN out-broke the competition and retained the advantage, got pounced upon by CONQUEST HARDCANDY as the first fraction was being finalized, went at it head to head with that foe all the way to the end of the far turn, waited until the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole before being asked for more, got headed by the winner shortly afterwards, fought on well and went on to earn the show. TIZZELLE hung out three wide on the clubhouse bend, dove onto a wide opening along path two midway on the backstretch, was still in it taking up the chase on the far turn, came under a ride heading into the lane, lacked the necessary response. CONQUEST HARDCANDY placed to snug hold by the pilot after springing from the starting gate, was under her own power rushing up to confront LADY JOAN, beginning the chore from path three and ending it one path closer to the rail, continued to be rated along leading by the earlier-mentioned for by a narrow margin, was the first to have its rider commit to stronger handling, this occurring as their spat spilled over into the lane, put up a fight until past the eighth pole then weakened. WAR CANOE sat reserved in path two, was called upon for more turning into the stretch, wandered six to seven wide making no impact. FEELING BOSSY stalked the front runners two to three wide and gave way. BONITA BIANCA made it over the rail in short order, cut the corner under a drive, came up empty.
