Free nomination by Wednesday, September 5. \$250 to enter, \$250 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed (Includes \$37,500 from the Mystic Lake Purse Enhancement Fund) of which \$45,000 to the owner of the winner. All purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in the Condition Book. Weights: Colts and Geldings - 122 lbs; Fillies - 119 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs, a race other than claiming allowed 4 lbs. Maidens allowed 6 lbs. MISTER BANJOMAN broke readily to press the pace between foes from the outset into the turn, edged clear racing into upper stretch, drifted out in the final sixteenth but just held TOPPER T to the wire under brisk handling. The latter broke out bumping KENAI BOB, was collected to track off the second flight early, advanced four wide on the turn to upper stretch steadily gaining position, was forced to shift outside the winner nearing the wire and just missed. KENAI BOB joined the pace four wide early pressing the issue into the turn, continued to pursue the leader past midstretch, then altered course inside the pacesetter when losing his path to that foe in the final stages but continued willingly while just failing to match the top pair. BROTHER RICHIE tracked just off the first flight while angling inside racing into the turn, switched out to bid between foes in late stages but had no final kick. I'M A G SIX settled along the inside early, shifted out four wide leaving the turn while being urged to gain position between foes and continued with a mild bid. GIANT MESA vied for command three wide between foes into the turn but gave way early. BLOOMIN PERFECT, urged inside foes pressing the pace racing to the turn, gave way nearing midstretch. PRINCE PIERCE tracked off the first flight inside rivals but faded nearing the lane. MUNNY MUNNINGS never gained contention. DRESS SHOPPING proved no factor. FULL OF GRACE dropped out early. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF KENAI BOB LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN LATE STRETCH WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
