OUR SAMMI went quickly to show the way, saved ground while showing the way, responded when challenged by SAVEITFORARAINYDAY, was given her cue at the quarter pole, drew away and remained clear under light handling. PARCAM COWGIRL raced under a strong hold then was in close quarters along the rail, leaving the opening turn, tracked the pacesetters, angled out to the three path leaving the back stretch, chased hard under heavy steady urging into the stretch but could not get to the winner. SMART FIX saved ground inside and rallied belatedly. PIPER ROSE trailed the field and closed late. LEENA raced three to four-wide in the first turn and lacked a closing response. SAVEITFORARAINYDAY sat just off the pace under a snug hold, overtook the pace by a slim margin, then was unable to match strides with the eventual winner and faded steadily inside. Due to the timer being tripped early, the final time was hand timed.
