SKY PROMISE settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail from between rivals through the stretch the first time, commenced his bid four wide entering the final turn, and closed with a rush one out from the rail in deep stretch to get up in the closing strides. The rider of SKY PROMISE dropped his whip in mid stretch. WEEKEND WIZARD away well and pressed the pace two wide entering the stretch the first time, continued to force the issue two wide in the run down the backstretch, sprinted to a clear advantage entering the final turn, but was unable to hold off the late charge of SKY PROMISE in the closing strides. CANADIAN GAME broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, set a pressured pace from along the rail through the second turn and in the run down the backstretch, was unable to match strides with WEEKEND WIZARD entering the final turn, but battled gamely to prove best of the rest. EL NOBLE away alertly and tracked the leader one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, loomed up three wide to force the issue in the run to the final turn, rallied two wide through the turn, and finished three wide in the drive in a solid effort. DAY RAIDER settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the stretch the first time, commenced his bid two wide entering the final turn, and finished one out from the rail in the stretch drive. BRAVE NATION settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and finished from along the rail in the drive. NOT YET unhurried early while dropping back to trail, began to gain ground on the far outside in the run to the final turn, continued four wide through the turn, and closed three wide in the drive. APALACHEE BAY settled off the early pace while racing three out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, advanced three wide in the run down the backstretch to gain a striking position in the run to the final turn, rallied three wide through the turn, but needed more late. TITOCHIP settled off the early pace while racing three out from the rail through the stretch the first time, rallied two wide through the final turn, but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. PICKFORD stalked the leaders from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, started to drop back in the run to the final turn, and had nothing to offer over the final furlong. Following the race PICKFORD was reported to have bled. CHEF lagged well off the early pace while racing two wide into the lane the first time, was always well back and failed to make his presence felt. WISE MARKET tracked the leaders from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, maintained his position in the run to the final turn, but faded in the late going.
