6½ FURLONGS. (1.15) JACK DIAMOND FUTURITY PURSE \$100,000 FOR BC BRED/BC Sired TWO YEAR OLD COLTS AND GELDINGS. By subscription of \$50 for each mare-in-foal or foal on ground nominated on or before March 24th, 2016. To remain eligible a further subscription of \$100 is due by Saturday April 7, 2018 (Two-Year-Old). Final payment of \$200 to accompany the nomination by Midnight Saturday August 25, 2018 with \$1500 to enter and an additional \$2,000 to start. \$100,000 guaranteed of which 55% goes to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 4% to fifth, and 2% sixth through eighth. Nominations are non-refundable. Preference will be based upon the rules outlined in Hastings condition book at the time of entry. Weight: 119 lbs. Non-winners of \$27,500 twice allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of \$27,500 allowed 5 lbs. Non-winners of \$10,000 allowed 7 lbs. Field limited to 11 starters.

DAT DAY stalked the leader into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, advanced three wide midway down the backstretch to chase the pacesetter two wide into the final turn, and wore that rival down in the final strides to prevail. ARRANGER away alertly and raced to the lead from just off the rail entering the backstretch, dictated the pace in the run down the backstretch, maintained his lead through the final turn, but was unable to hold off DAT DAY in the final strides in a game effort. CALL IT A WRAP settled off the early pace while racing three wide into the backstretch, commenced his bid four wide approaching the final turn, and finished three wide in the drive to be along for a share. PADDY D'ORO broke sharply and tracked the leader from along the rail entering the backstretch, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, and closed from along the rail in the drive in a solid effort. VOLO VELOCE settled mid pack while saving ground along the inside entering the backstretch, rallied two wide entering the final turn, and finished evenly four wide in the drive. JACK DON'T DRINK unhurried early while dropping back to trail, rallied from along the rail from the back of the pack approaching the final turn, and finished with late interest three wide in the drive. STAY FANTASTIC was squeezed soon after the start, and settled well off the early leaders while racing three wide into the backstretch, rallied two out from the rail entering the final turn, and finished six wide in the drive. ALEUTIAN HARBOUR raced rank in the early stages while in tight quarters along the rail in the run to the first turn, settled well off the early pace from along the rail entering the backstretch, rallied five wide through the final turn, and failed to make a late impact while racing four out from the rail in the drive. BUGSY away well and stalked the leader into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong. HORST stalked the leader from just off the rail entering the backstretch, held a striking trip in the run to the final turn, but faded over the final furlong. LORD OF THE NORTH settled off the early pace while racing one out from the rail entering the backstretch, dropped back to trail in the run to the final turn, and offered nothing over the final furlong.
