SUMMERLAND away alertly and raced to the lead while keeping one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, dictated the pace while staying two wide in the run down the backstretch and into the final turn, and finished determinedly three wide in the drive to hold off DANCIN SHOES to prove best. DANCIN SHOES broke sharply and tracked the leader into the stretch the first time while racing two out from the rail, forced the issue three wide in the run down the backstretch and into the final turn, and closed willingly four wide in the drive to prove easily second best. FRIDAY settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the stretch the first time, continued to save ground through the second turn and gained a stalking trip behind the top pair entering the backstretch, was unable to keep tabs on the leaders through the final turn, but finished from along the rail in the drive to hold on for a share. GIFTED GREY settled off the early pacesetters while racing one out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, gained ground through the second turn to hold a stalking position at the back of a compact field entering the backstretch, began to lose touch with the top pair approaching the final turn, but finished willingly two wide in the drive.
