CODY'S CHOICE sprinted clear at once, raced four-wide while setting the pace, drifted out further approaching the stretch and drew off through the lane with complete authority. PAPA FRANK chased the winner while racing five-wide, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to hold the place. GRINDER SPARKSAGLO was off a step slow, settled off the leaders early, raced five-wide through the turn, angled out further into the stretch and finished evenly late. GRAVEL lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with some late run. CANTCHACO settled off the leaders early, raced three-wide through the turn and failed to rally. THE PRESS chased the leaders while racing three-wide for a half and weakened. WESTLEY was off a step slow, lacked early foot, raced four-wide through the turn and was not a factor. CALIFORNIA FLASH lagged throughout and raced four-wide through the turn.
