

1 1/8 MILES. (147) COMELY S. Grade III. Purse \$200,000 FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over in 2018 allowed 3 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over lifetime or three races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races allowed 5 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 10, 2018 with 18 Nominations.

BLAMED established the front and showed the way rated on the pace along the inside under attendance from ALBEROBELLO to the outside but little pressure until that foe came under coaxing half a mile from home, remained patiently handled while given a notch to keep her advantage, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home and was set down for the drive straightened away, drew clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat and held safe to prevail. REMEDY lost all footing at the start her legs splaying and nearly belly flopped conceding three to four lengths immediately to the front, raced four then three wide through the first turn before settling four wide down the backstretch near the rear of the field, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths and advanced through the latter portion of the turn angling five wide into upper stretch under a drive, dug in offering up a good finish to close in late issuing a growing threat to the eventual winner and latched on that rival as she hit the wire showing good courage after a rough beginning. INDY UNION three wide through the first turn, settled two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, tipped out four wide put to coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung six wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top pair while keeping on to secure the show honors. SPLIT TIME broke out a step at the start bumping HEY NIKI, tracked the pace along the inside until tipped to the two path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths tipping out four wide near the three-eighths, advanced on the front nearing the quarter pole, went three to four wide at that station, weakened in the late stages. HEY NIKI bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. STRONGER THAN EVER just off the inside near the rear, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, angled five wide at the quarter pole and tired. ALBEROBELLO forwardly placed from the start, attended the leader three wide, came under coaxing half a mile from home two to three wide, got shaken off through the latter portion of the far turn, swung three wide into upper stretch and faltered. WAR CABINET two to three wide in pursuit from near the rear, got coaxed along at the seven-sixteenths, went four wide for home and made no impact. Please note that all jockeys carried an additional two pounds under a weather safety initiative.
