1 MILE. (Turf) (1.33³) BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE FILLIES TURF Grade I. Purse \$1,000,000 FOR FILLIES, TWO-YEAR-OLDS. Weight: 122 lbs. \$15,000 to pre-enter, \$15,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$1 million purse including travel awards of which 55% to the owner of the winner, 17% to second, 9% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 1% to sixth, 1% to seventh, 1% to eighth; plus travel awards to starters not based in Kentucky. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile.)

NEWSPAPEROFRECORD (IRE) quickly cleared and set a rated pace removed from the hedge, entered the lane in about the four path, eagerly widened after being roused soon after, remained under steady hand encouragement to the sixteenth marker then was geared down through the final seventy yards while proving much the best. EAST (GB), unhurried well off the pace saved ground into the far turn, angled out and edged up behind foes leaving the quarter pole, waited briefly then swung out seven wide, straightened to split rivals and kept on gamely to grab the place in the final strides. STELLAR AGENT chased the pace while saving ground, moved up into the stretch, raced in closest pursuit past the furlong grounds and continued with interest. JUST WONDERFUL broke in the air, regrouped and saved ground, swung six wide gathering momentum into the lane and kept on trying to the wire. VARENKA lagged well off the early pace, angled extremely wide in upper stretch, straightened and had late action. THE MACKEM BULLET (IRE) steadied off heels early, advanced to a forward position around the first turn, gave hard chase past the quarter pole, shifted out late but came up empty. BELLE LAURA, wide in mid pack, angled eight wide while between foes into the lane but lacked a legitimate kick. CONCRETE ROSE saved ground advancing to the far turn, eased out and was put to a strong ride soon after, remained a presence past the three sixteenths then gave way. MY GAL BETTY leaned in at the break tightening a rival, settled in the clear near the half mile pole, angled nine wide for the drive and lacked a bid. LA PELOSA (IRE) rushed to contention, stalked the pace three wide, was under pressure trying to keep pace past the five sixteenths and weakened. PAKHET, four wide stalking the pace, failed to kick on under a ride past the three eighths and gave way. LILY'S CANDLE (FR), between rivals leaving the five eighths marker, raced in range to the far turn then weakened. SUMMERING, in close at the break, raced four wide around the first turn, angled in for the drive and failed to threaten. LADY PRANCEALOT (IRE) steadied along early and was not a factor.
