THUNDER DOME settled into stride in about the five to six path early off the leaders, moved four to five wide on the far turn to take the lead at the three-sixteenths, quickly kicked clear and held safe. SHINING SOURCE switched off the inside heading up the backstretch, swung five wide into the lane, captured place while no threat to the winner. GO FOR A STROLL settled in the rear half, began to advance swinging seven wide for the drive, could not get second but was best of the rest. STREAKS BRO stalked the clear early leader before moving to challenge that one, took a narrow lead briefly leaving the far turn, lacked the needed late kick. HUTE stalked four wide and between runners early, was able to shift in a path or so on the far turn while still within range of the leaders, came in further in upper stretch and ran on evenly. HIT A LICK chased from between foes early, shifted in entering the far turn to save some ground, came out for room in upper stretch, kept on. DOM STRAIT settled racing off the inside, swung six wide and passed rivals. GOLD BOUNDRY was forwardly-positioned five wide early outside the second flight, took closer order after encouragement three furlongs from home but was empty in the lane. G M GAGE bobbled and exchanged light contact at the break, passed tired foes. BOOMER WHO was bumped at the break, forwardly-placed inside, checked about the three-eighths when in tight. MR. DIGGER fanned seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. KRIS WHO bumped the outer foe at the break, sped clear, faltered and faded. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF BOOMER WHO AGAINST HIT A LICK ALLEGING INTERFERENCE ON THE FAR TURN NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
