Final closing on November 14, 2018 at \$500. \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed of which \$60,000 to the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: Three Year Old - 122 lbs; Older - 124 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes in 2018 allowed 2 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 twice in 2018 allowed 4 lbs. Non-winners of three races other than maiden, claiming or starter in 2018 allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Louisiana Champions Day Sprint will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2018. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. GIVEMEAMINIT settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole, angled out inside the three-sixteenths, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up in the final strides. DIVINE BEAN was well placed just off the pace, drafted inside to the two path on the turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole then was asked, took the lead under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted out when switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, switched back to a right-handed whip and was denied while able to get the place. MONTE MAN came away in good order, set the pace, vied in the two path on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage in upper stretch, fought on well into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while well clear for the show. JOCKAMO'S SONG settled off the pace, was asked in the three path on the turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and lacked the needed response. MY FRIEND FLAVIN settled on the outside, steadied briefly near the seven-sixteenths, rounded the turn in the two to three path, was roused at the quarter-pole and failed to respond. WONDER RUN tracked the pace under restraint, made a bid at the half-mile pole, vied in the three then four path on the turn, dropped back late on that bend and came up empty. GREELEY WENT WEST was void of speed, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. JACK SNIPE'S was urged along while well back on the outside, went around the turn in the two to three path, spun four wide into the lane and was no factor. CHEERS TO BERTI chased the pace on the outside, went four then five wide on the turn, passed the five-sixteenths under the whip and stopped.
