NOBLE COMMANDER set the pace on the inside, was asked at the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch under a drive in the two path, responded well under vigorous urging and proved best. MARZO went four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, pursued the winner in the drive and finished willingly while second best. BALLARD HIGH went three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while inside early on the far turn, angled three wide near the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and was out-kicked while able to get the show. LUSITANO bumped with a rival after the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace under some restraint, was taken up while inside early on the far turn, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. RERIDE went three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch while in striking range but flattened out. MCFEELY saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. G'S TURN rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved under a tight hold, dropped from the two path to the rail while under urging on the far turn and failed to rally. ZERO GRAVITY bumped with a foe just after the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, was urged along in the five path on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and was no factor. CALL WEST went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, came up empty in the three then two path on the far turn and retreated. TWOKO BAY broke a step slow, went four wide on the first turn, dropped well behind, rounded the far turn in the two path and failed to respond.
