PUMPKIN RUMBLE was away in midpack, raced two-wide throughout, began his bid heading into the final turn, reached the leader approaching the 1/4 pole, was quickly headed by MELMICH, dueled with that foe down the stretch, lost the lead for a few strides but dug in gamely and prevailed. MELMICH raced in midpack, was two-wide on the first two turns, inched closer racing down the backstretch, commenced a bid racing two and three-wide on the final turn, headed PUMPKIN RUMBLE entering the stretch, dueled, had the lead in midstretch but was outgamed by his stablemate in the late yards. VINTAGE MATTERS stalked the pacesetter while saving ground, was in contention on the far turn, angled off of the rail at the 1/4 pole, was no match for the top two in the stretch but was still well clear of the rest. BANGKOK raced near the back early, trailed the field entering the clubhouse turn where he raced two-wide, was widest of all on the backstretch, raced three-wide on the final turn and closed in the stretch. A. A. AZULA'S ARCH got out to set an unpressured pace, saved ground throughout, was headed nearing the 1/4 pole, had nothing to offer the new leaders and lost minor positions late in the stretch. ENGLISH ILLUSION was unhurried while saving ground in the early stages, angled off of the rail on the backstretch, commenced a bid on the far turn racing three and four-wide then evened out in the stretch. BOWSPRIT raced in midpack on the inside, maintained position throughout, angled two-wide at the 1/4 pole then offered no closing response. ETHICAL FUNDS tracked the pacesetter, raced two-wide throughout and faltered on the final turn. SEEKING ALBERT broke slowly, trailed the field early, came off of the rail as they entered the stretch for the first time then passed a foe, was three-wide on the second turn, went back to trailing the field on the backstretch then offered no rally.
