By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstake in 2018-19 allowed 3 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-Bred Allowance since May 1, 2018 allowed 5 lbs. HONOR UP three wide in pursuit from near the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final furlong, knocked heads with the runner up taking command narrowly a sixteenth from home and prevailed gamely on the wire. SYNDERGAARD coaxed from the gate, raced four then three wide in aim of the front, got set down nearing the quarter pole and poked a head in front at that station before swinging four wide for home, dug in under threat from a trio fending them off before emerging head to head with the aforementioned foe, got headed for command near the sixteenth pole, dug in gamely fighting on to the finish. GOLD FOR THE KING broke in at the start brushing with JEWEL CAN DISCO, was taken hold and steadied six and a half furlongs from home off the heels of ROYAL ASSET who crossed in front, settled under a hold just off the pace just off the inside, came under light and brief coaxing swinging four wide for home before being in behind foes to the eighth pole, had a seam open up at that station, got roused on through bidding mildly while not having enough to match the top pair while along for the show honors. MORNING BREEZ five paths off the inside in pursuit down the backstretch, tucked three to four wide at the five-eighths, chased four wide through the turn advancing to striking range midway, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home and weakened in the late stages. CELTIC CHAOS grew detached three wide at the tail of the field early on, came under coaxing four wide at the three-eighths, continued four wide into upper stretch making headway, dug in under a drive and had the rider lose the handle on the stick near the sixteenth marker while improving position albeit never threatening the top trio. ROYAL ASSET was forwardly placed crossing three then two wide which in turn forced GOLD FOR THE KING to be taken in hand off his heels six and a half furlongs out before knocking heads with JEWEL CAN DISCO through to the half mile pole, took over command inside that station and shook a bit away coming under pressure from SYNDERGAARD to the outside, got placed to urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home headed for command, weakened in the stretch. WINSTON'S CHANCE five wide in pursuit, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, went six wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the drive. JEWEL CAN DISCO brushed at the start by GOLD FOR THE KING while coaxed from the gate, showed the way along the inside coaxed along and under pressure from ROYAL ASSET to the outside, got headed by that rival into the turn, retreated through the bend urged along, swung three wide into upper stretch and faltered.
