Non-winners of a Grade I or Grade II stake allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a Graded stake allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

BELLAFINA pressed the pace between horses then dueled outside the runner-up, took a short lead on the turn, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear, was shaken up once with the reins to widen in midstretch and drew off without further encouragement. MOTHER MOTHER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, came out into the stretch and held second. TOMLIN broke on top and bumped with a rival, had speed off the rail then between foes, fell back and angled in, stalked inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and bested the others. REFLECT had speed outside foes then stalked off the rail or outside rivals, went four wide into and out of the turn and weakened. SOLD IT bumped at the start, pressed the pace three deep then stalked off the rail into the turn, continued alongside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
