

1 MILE. (1.322) HAYNESFIELD S. Purse \$100,000 (plus \$5,425 Starters Bonus) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD FOALD IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE-BRED REGISTRY. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstake at a mile of over since May 1, 2018 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake in 2018-19 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance in 2018-19 allowed 6 lbs. HONOR UP came inward taking an awkward initial step due to the ground appearing to give way, was patiently ridden and allowed to settle into stride during the trip on the chute, tipped to the outside, departed the backstretch from path three, crept up to STONEY BENNETT as three-quarters was being reached, turned for home in a practical dead head with the aforementioned foe, had already struck the front end by a narrow margin when given his cue in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths marker, edged away, came out at spots during the final furlong, fortuitously aided though as SYNDERGAARD was likewise unable to keep a true course, arrived at the wire in time to prevail. SYNDERGAARD gradually made his way to the inside after the start, getting there by the top of the backstretch, inched out at the top of the turn so as to be able to draft behind STONEY, got cued up commencing to angle to the outside past the five-sixteenths marker, eventually making it into the three path, lugged in momentarily at the three-sixteenths marker, the location where many lead switches are undertaken, chipped away at the deficit leaving the eighth pole, drifting out at times during it all, forged on ahead with determination, would end up losing but barely. TWISTED TOM away in good order, dove over to the rail at the half mile pole, continued to track the front runners from near the back of the pack, swung into action by being fanned out five wide into the stretch, had a good finish down the center of the strip to earn the show. FIERY OPAL off the inside, took up the chase two to three wide, got put to a drive midpoint on the turn, swung about four wide into the lane, lacked the needed response in the final furlong. STONEY BENNETT grabbed control shortly after the start, was rated on the lead, spaced at a slight distance from off the rail, pulling lightly on the light, was put to a drive when put to the test at the quarter pole, relinquished and backed away. LOKI'S VENGEANCE underwent a three wide pursuit, was under some coaxing spinning into the lane, then proceeded to fade away. All riders carried an additional two pounds as mandated by a weather-related safety initiative.
