SILVER DUST was fractious in the gate, broke a bit awkwardly, went three to four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the three path on the far turn, led into the stretch then moved clear at the three-sixteenths, drifted out while still clear at the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. HARLAN PUNCH was taken up while rank early, swerved out into the first turn, went six wide on that bend, settled on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and finished willingly for the place then was vanned off after the race. FLAMEAWAY went to the front, raced inside to the two path on the first turn, set the pace through tepid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths, lost the lead coming to the quarter-pole and weakened but just held the show. THIRD DAY was rated just off the pace on the inside, came under urging leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, dropped back late on that bend, turned into the stretch in the two path, gained some ground in the final furlong and just missed the show. PHAT MAN went four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid the two path while ridden along on the far turn, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. LONE SAILOR was last to commence, went three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, saved ground on the far turn and improved position without threatening. LONG ON LUCK went two to three wide on the first turn, was rated off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths, moved out around the sixteenth-pole and came up empty. KREWE CHIEF became very rank early and was taken up, rounded the first turn in the two path while still keen, was reserved towards the back, came under urging on the far turn, angled four wide at the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. BALLARD HIGH went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, rounded the far turn in the two path, came four wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. MO DONT NO went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
