SENOR FRIDAY saved ground early, eased off the inside and moved up on the backstretch, bid three wide on the far turn and reached the front passing the eighth pole then drove clear. PARKING PERMIT between rivals nearing the far turn, raced along the rail turning for home, was in a bit close briefly, was between foes again nearing the sixteenth pole and finished gamely for the place. PRINCE PIERCE up close early inside then continued up close and between rivals leaving the backstretch, raced just off the rail turning for home and finished willingly while needing more. MIDNIGHT REVERIE a bit unsettled briefly in the gate and between rivals rounding the clubhouse turn, also raced up close and vied for command outside DR JOHN H on the far turn, battled into midstretch then yielded through the late stages. DR JOHN H three wide on the clubhouse turn, moved to the front on the backstretch and was inside on the far turn, continued to vie for command then weakened in the drive. TEQUILA COWBOY raced just off the inside turning for home and lacked the needed rally. CHARLIE IRISH broke in some, raced outside down the backstretch and lacked the needed response. KEYSON a bit fractious in the gate, set the early pace, saved ground into the far turn and gradually gave way. The quarter and mile fractional splits were hand timed.
