By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over since May 1, 2018 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstake over a mile in 2018-19 or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance over a mile since September 1, 2018 allowed 4 lbs.; of one such race since then allowed 6 lbs. ROYAL ALBERT HALL (GB) crossed directly to the two path shortly after the start settling unhurried near the rear just off the inside past the stands for the initial time and through the opening bend, took to the three path down the backstretch, advanced in tandem with the field on the once clear leader half a mile from home remaining patiently handled three wide into and through the far turn until placed to coaxing at the three-eighths, angled four wide into upper stretch finding a seam as WEATHER WIZ backed out, dug in under a drive steadily gaining outside to issue a challenge through the final furlong seizing command just inside the sixteenth marker, then inched away to the finish to prevail. HIT IT ONCE MORE hustled from the gate, vied from the five path with LEITONE to his inside past the stand for the first time, had that rival sneak a peek back seeing the developing gap back to the rest and conceded the front into the first turn, took over command at that juncture tucking to the two path nearing the midway point on the opening bend and showing the way clear in front and uncontested, tucked inside into the backstretch under a grip and slowing the pace, had the field advance nearing the half mile pole, got given some rein to work with receiving a tap at that station to the off side, held the front safely through the far turn coming under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, got let out spinning along the inside into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole clear once more but coming under growing threat from a pair to the outside, dug in gallantly but was displaced just inside the sixteenth pole, then ran on to preserve the place honors in a solid effort. SHALAKO six paths off the inside past the stand for the first turn, raced four wide through the first turn before taking back to the five path down the backstretch, advanced in tandem on the once spurting leader half a mile from home, came under urging four wide at the seven-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive keeping on through to the finish while clear for the show honors. FOREWARNED four paths off the inside past the stands the first time, chased three wide through the first turn allowed to settle at the tail of the field, tucked inside down the backstretch, came under coaxing half a mile from home saving ground through the far turn and taking the inside route into upper stretch, then offered up a mild bid to procure the last major share. HOLIDAY BONUS three wide early on, chased just off the inside through the opening bend and down the backstretch in mid pack, came under coaxing tucked to the rail half a mile from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. LEITONE (CHI) showed speed vying from the four path to the inside of HIT IT ONCE MORE past the stands for the first time before the rider snuck a peek back and wrangled his charge tucking three wide into the first turn and conceding the front, raced two to three wide in closest aim of the spurting leader isolated briefly into the backstretch before being joined by the main flight as they closed the gap as a group half a mile from home, came under coaxing three furlongs out, swung three wide into upper stretch and tired. WEATHER WIZ six paths off the inside early on, tucked three wide through the first turn before chasing unhurried four then three wide down the backstretch, came under a ride three wide at the three-eighths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch backing away and tired in the stretch. All riders carried an additional two pounds as mandated by a weather-related safety initiative.
