CORE BELIEFS went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, made a bid while three to four wide on the far turn, led into the stretch then was put to a drive, battled with the runner-up into the final furlong, drifted in and out from the whip between that point and the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. SILVER DUST went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide while ranging up at the five-sixteenths, made a bid while four wide into the stretch, battled outside of the winner in the drive and was outfinished while able to get the place. LONE SAILOR broke a bit slow, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, moved closer while four wide on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths then moved to five wide, came six wide into the stretch and finished with good courage for the show. BANDUA rounded the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, drafted near the inside on the far turn, turned into the stretch in the two path, steadied briefly outside the three-sixteenths, chased into the final furlong and was out-kicked. COPPER BULLET rounded the first turn in the two path, settled between horses, raced in the two path on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths then angled four wide, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. NOBLE INDY broke through the front of the gate prior to the start, was brought back around and reloaded, contested the pace on the inside, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost the lead into upper stretch and tired. SOUPER TAPIT broke a step slow, settled on the inside, moved closer midway down the backstretch, saved ground while behind a foe early on the far turn, was roused inside the three-eighths pole and came up empty. KREWE CHIEF climbed behind a rival into the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, settled last but one, went two to three wide on the far turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and failed to threaten. MR. BUFF went around the first turn in the three path, contested the pace on the outside, was asked in the two path on the far turn, dropped back while three wide into the stretch and stopped then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
