BY MY STANDARDS raced in the two path on the first turn, was well placed towards the front, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was asked while three wide into the stretch, dropped in while put to a drive at the three-sixteenths, rallied into the final furlong, made a bid outside the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong handling. SPINOFF bumped with a rival just after the start, went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, held a length advantage into the final furlong, was challenged by the winner outside the sixteenth-pole and missed while well clear for the place. SUENO tracked the leader in the three path on the first turn, moved up to prompt the pace while outside on the backstretch, vied in the three path on the far turn, took the lead outside the quarter-pole, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened but held the show. COUNTRY HOUSE broke a step slow, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along midway down the backstretch, advanced six wide under urging on the far turn, chased under the whip into upper stretch and tired. MR. MONEY was taken in hand between rivals nearing the first turn, went five then four wide on that bend, settled on the outside, advanced five wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch and came up empty. ROILAND broke a step slow, saved ground on the first turn, moved closer with a half-mile to run, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was roused at the quarter-pole and failed to respond. BANKIT broke out and hit the gate, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, started the far turn in the two path, angled five wide while moving closer near the five-sixteenths, came seven wide into the stretch and had nothing left. HOG CREEK HUSTLE bumped with a rival just after the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, rounded the far turn in the three path, was asked near the quarter-pole, dropped inward in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. WAR OF WILL lost his footing in the hindquarters after the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, moved closer midway down the backstretch, was roused while three wide on the far turn, spun four wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. LIMONITE rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, moved closer while four wide on the far turn, was driven five wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. LEMNISCATE went straight to the front, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead outside the quarter-pole and faded. ALL TIMES WERE HAND-TIMED DUE TO TIMER MALFUNCTION
