Weight: 123 lbs. GRANDE BASIN settled on the inside, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came under a drive in upper stretch, rallied while hugging the rail and closed well to get up inside the runner-up late. POUND FOR POUND went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, set the clear pace, was asked in the two path on the far turn, passed the five-sixteenths under the whip, came out some at the three-sixteenths, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while clear for the place. PAYDAY TOO brushed with a rival at the start then was taken in hand, moved in early, raced inside early on the first turn then moved to the two path, was reserved off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path, was roused at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MAGEEZ went three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BUDRO TALKING raced in the four path on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging in the four path on the far turn, spun five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. UNDERPRESSURE brushed with a foe at the start, raced in the five path on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked in the five path on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and came up empty. GLADYOUSAWME went around the first turn in the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, raced in the three path on the far turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch and tired.
