

1³/₈ MILES. (Turf) (2.104) MAC DIARMIDA S. Grade II. Purse \$200,000 FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, February 17. \$2,000 to enter. \$200,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at nine furlongs or over on turf since September 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes on turf since September 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off turf, it will be run at the distance of one and one-quarter miles and may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Quarter) (Rail at 24 feet).

ZULU ALPHA settled in striking range three wide through the stretch the first time, remained in the three-path through the second and third turns, bid widest of a foursome battling for the lead in midstretch, and edged away late. MELMICH lagged well back early, swung out five wide late on the final turn, lugged in through midstretch, got back on track under left-hand urging and finished strongly on the far outside to get up for second. KULIN ROCK was never far back, saved ground through the second and third turns, stayed on the fence getting through inside VILLAGE KING in upper stretch, and battled gamely to the wire. CHANNEL MAKER was keyed up prompting the pace outside VILLAGE KING from the start, challenged for command in the three-path between rivals through the stretch, and was outkicked. VILLAGE KING (ARG) rated along through manageable fractions inside, came under siege from both flanks in the two-path coming off the final turn, and yielded late between rivals. HUNTER O'RILEY saved ground through most of the first mile, swung four wide off the final turn and passed tired horses outside. MONTCLAIR (IRE) stayed in range three then two wide on the turns between horses, and lacked a solid response. GOLDEN DRAGON broke alertly and vied inside VILLAGE KING briefly, dropped back approaching the stretch the first time, saved ground the rest of the way and could not muster the needed response. HIGHLAND SKY was three wide early, stayed in range four wide through the second and third turns, and was empty into the stretch the final time. VETTORI KIN (BRZ) raced three wide between rivals much of the way, shifted in coming off the final turn and gave way. THE BEST CANDY steadied along in the three-path and bobbled midway on the opening bend, and dropped back to trail entering the backstretch the second time.
