SENIOR SENATOR was unhurried on the outside in the middle of the pack, steadily advanced from the twelfth fence then quickened near the third-last fence to draw off after the second-last fence and increased his lead in hand. JOSHUA G. was never far back but couldn't stay with the winner. RAVEN'S CHOICE pressed the early pace, led to the second-last fence and tired. DRIFT SOCIETY (IRE) pressed the pace to the second-last fence and tired. HILL TIE was outrun but completed the course. WILDCATTER pressed the pace, hit the outside flag on the seventh fence, continued on competitively for five more fences, dropped back quite a distance but completed the course. MONSTALEUR rated near the back of the pack, rallied from the twelfth fence, had a strong rally up the hill to be closest to the winner but stumbled at the final fence and unseated his rider. He walked off. SOVEREIGN FUND was outrun throughout and was far back when he unseated his rider on landing the final fence. He walked off. CLASS INDIAN pressed the early pace, was taken in hand to stalk the pace in the middle of the pack, rallied from the twelfth fence, loomed boldly three fences out but stumbled at the second-last fence unseating his rider. He walked off. ARDRAHAN (GB) was unhurried through eleven fences, steadily advanced to loom boldly three fences out, fell landing the second-last fence and was euthanized. OLD TIMER led early, pressed the pace, was challenged for the lead near the twelfth fence, hit it hard, continued on for two more fences then was pulled up and walked off. GAS CAN EDDIE was outrun on the outside, hit the seventh fence, unseated his rider and walked off.
