QUEBEC showed speed from outside position, cleared on top then angled inside, set the pace saving ground through backstretch, held firm along rail in far turn, put to drive turning for home, came out three wide then kept sharp. FOOLS GOLD allowed to settle out of the gate, continued unhurried and saved ground through backstretch, picked up pace and circled closer in far turn, set down driving six path upper stretch, came in path and brushed with MIDNIGHT SOIREE near furlong marker then kept on with good response. SUPERCOMMITTEE rated along outside just off early pace, made three wide bid and advanced position at quarter pole, driving left handed in stretch and kept on for share. MIDNIGHT SOIREE raced near midpack through backstretch, commenced steady advance through far turn, set down driving five wide upper stretch, brushed with FOOLS GOLD near furlong marker then finished evenly. HOGANS HOLIDAY was unhurried racing two to three wide in the backstretch, circled wide into stretch then finished with interest. BITACORA settled in early stages, urged to pick up pace near half mile marker, raced along inside then two path leaving turn, set down for drive racing three wide and had mild improve. MALKIA raced in range early stages, failed to kick on in the turn then weakened in stretch. SUSIE BEE settled nicely racing off the pace, made three to four wide bid in far turn then shuffled bit and failed to move on. CROWN AND SUGAR stalked the leader through backstretch, made bid for lead in far turn then faded in stretch. FLOSSIE raced in range through backstretch, hustled up along rail at three eighths pole, failed to sustain bid into stretch. TOO CHARMING stalked the leader through backstretch, hustled up two wide in far turn then retreated upper stretch.
