

7 FURLONGS. (1:21) MADISON S. Grade I. Purse \$300,000 FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$9,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth and \$6,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since November 2 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade I or Grade II since September 1, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Madison will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen fillies or mares pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2018-2019 earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Wednesday, March 20, 2019 with 30 nominations.

SPICED PERFECTION bumped with LATE NIGHT POW WOW at the start, was quickly into stride and tracked AMY'S CHALLENGE three deep, forged a slim lead nearing the furlong marker, dug in and held that determined foe at bay. AMY'S CHALLENGE pulled to the fore to dictate terms off of the inside, was headed with a furlong to run, fought on gamely but was unable to resist the winner. LATE NIGHT POW WOW bumped with the winner at the start, chased the leaders three wide, was unable to go on with the top two but kept on well to hold the show. AMERICA'S TALE tucked in to save ground and was forwardly placed, got through entering the stretch, but lacked the needed late response. SHAMROCK ROSE settled in hand, ranged up five wide on the turn, was forced out a bit deeper to avoid CATHEDRAL READER leaving the quarter pole, and failed to make headway in the drive. DIVINE QUEEN attended the pace along the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and faded. SULTRY was slow into stride, finished with a belated improvement, but was never a factor. CREATE A STAR settled off of the inside, angled out leaving the turn, was forced wider still to avoid the stricken rival and never recovered. CATHEDRAL READER attended the pace four wide, bid between rivals leaving the turn, went wrong near the quarter pole, was pulled up sharply and vanned off. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the turn out of the turn, but following the review made no change to the order of finish.
