1 MILE. (Turf) (1.332) APPALACHIAN S. PRESENTED BY JAPAN RACING ASSOCIATION Grade II. Purse \$200,000 FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth, \$6,000 to fifth, and \$4,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade II stakes at a mile or over on the turf, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Appalachian will be limited to fourteen with two also eligibles. In the event that more than fourteen fillies pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 20, 2019 with 48 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile on the main track.

THE MACKEM BULLET (IRE) pressed the pace early on, shifted into the three path in the far turn, took over command into the lane, drew clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. REGAL GLORY was unhurried early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. PRINCESA CAROLINA chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn while making a bid but flattened out late in the stretch run. HARD LEGACY chased the pace early while widest, was in the six path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but leveled off late in the drive. WINNING ENVELOPE was back early on, fanned into the seven path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. PRIMELE (FR) was bumped hard at the start and trailed the field early on, was in the six path into the lane, altered out widest once in the stretch and moved up late. CATCH A THRILL set the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and gave way late in the stretch run. CLAUSE stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch drive. ANGEL ALESSANDRA stalked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, was bothered a bit in the stretch and tired in the final stages. NAUGHTY JOKER was through after a half. BEAUTIFUL BALLAD broke out at the start and was through after a half.
