

5½ FURLONGS. (Turf) (1.012) LIMESTONE TURF SPRINT PRINTS. Purse \$100,000 FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$3,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed, of which 60,000 to the owner of the winner, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,500 twice on the turf since September 28 allowed 3 lbs.; a graded stakes on the turf, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Limestone Turf Sprint will be limited to fourteen with two also eligibles. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf and synthetic earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a set of two silver julep cups to the winning owner. Closed Wednesday, March 27, 2019 with 47 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at the Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.

GINGER NUT (IRE) was unhurried early on, swung into the six path in the turn, rallied down the lane, swept past the leader and cleared the field in the final stages. STILLWATER COVE tracked the pace early, fanned into the five path in the turn, took over command and inched clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. CHELSEA CLOISTERS was bumped at the start, chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. BEECHWOOD ELLA (IRE) trailed the field early on, fanned into the seven path in the turn, rallied down the lane with a late gain in the final stages. THRIVING (GB) was bumped and bothered at the start, stalked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. BOHEMIAN BOURBON was back early on, fanned into the five path in the turn and improved position down the lane. PLAY ON was bumped at the start, pressed the pace early, shifted into the three path in the turn and faded late in the stretch. BLAME THE FROG was on the inside into the lane and was empty late in the stretch drive. RAINTREE STARLET veered out at the start, checked in the turn, was in the seven path entering the lane. WEABIE was through after a half. SNOW BLOSSOM broke out at the start then was rushed up to set the early pace and caved down the lane. ELLE'S TOWN was through early.
