MYSTIC STRIKE pressed the pace, led midway in the race, dropped back after the thirteen fence, rallied up the hill to duel after the fifteen fence and drew clear seventy yards out under strong urging. WITOR (GER) was unhurried for nine fences, steadily advance to duel for the lead before the fourteenth fence, battled the winner over the final fence and gave a game effort. LEMONY BAY (GB) stalked the pace, rallied up the hill to loom boldly two fences up then weakened in the stretch. AQUIES trailed to the twelfth fence and lacked a rally. DERWINS PROSPECTOR was outrun and outdistanced after the thirteen fence but completed the course. DOC CEBU dueled early, stalked the pace in the lower part of the course, moved up to lead at the eighth fence, dueled or led to the second-last fence, stumbled and lost his rider then walked off. GRAND MANAN set the pace through seven fences, gave way then pulled up before the fourteenth fences and walked off. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF WITOR AGAINST THE RIDER OF MYSTIC STRIKE ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN TWO LOCATIONS. WAS NOT ALLOWED.
