Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$3,000 which qualified to start with \$150,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$75,000 in 2018-2019 allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 since November 14, 2018 allowed 5lbs.; \$35,000 since February 14, 2019 allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Closed Thursday, March 28, 2019 with 37 nominees.

FIGHT ON broke readily, raced four wide in the opening stages tracking just off the leaders, continued three deep in second flight into the backstretch, was prompted to advance in that path on the far turn, moved to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch, then resisted the challenge of CASINO STAR in a prolonged drive to narrowly prevail on the wire under strong handling despite being carried out late. The latter gained a forward placing between foes tracking just off the pace racing to the backstretch, was prompted to bid between foes just inside the eventual winner nearing upper stretch, lost the advantage to that foe but produced a solid second effort to regain terms with that rival drifting out under brisk left handed encouragement to just miss. GATO GUAPO, forwardly placed along the rail prompting the pacesetter into the backstretch, conceded some position to track just off that foe along the inside racing into the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and produced a belated response to prevail for a share. HAWAAKOM tracked off the second flight along the rail under light reserve in the opening half, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, then came through close quarters along the rail to improve his position late. SNAPPER SINCLAIR broke a step slowly, was rated outside foes tracking off the second flight into the backstretch, continued four wide racing into the far turn to gain some position but lacked the needed closing response. SECRET PASSAGE, rank between foes just off the inside racing into the first turn, was wrangled back, shifted about racing through the backstretch, then angled five wide racing into upper stretch but proved no threat. NOBLE INDY, urged to the fore outside a rival forcing the pace into the first turn, angled to the inside once gaining a clear advantage after a half, set the pace along the inside into the far turn but gave way once headed by the top pair. MATROOH settled between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily faded nearing the lane. ROCKY TOUGH settled last racing to the backstretch, was caught five wide racing into the far turn and lacked a rally.
