PERFORMANCE REVIEW trailed early, coaxed along and began to advance about three to four wide and between rivals on the turn, swung seven deep for the stretch run and under a drive struck the lead near the sixteenth pole before drawing clear. BAYDAR set the pace inside but off the fence, kicked just clear in upper stretch, drifted out through mid-stretch and was overtaken by the aforementioned but was second best. KRAM settled early, advanced five then four wide to make a mild bid on the turn but evened out in the stretch. VICTIM OF LOVE tracked from between rivals in behind the leaders, lacked a late kick. SUPER HUMOR had brief speed attending the pace from outside, began to drop back leaving the backstretch, went four to five wide on the turn and was thoroughly asked for run about the five-sixteenths, came out a bit wider for the drive and kept on under urging. HARKING pressed the pace from outside going three wide through the turn, lacked the needed late kick. RAIDER raced mid-pack not too far off the leaders, eased back and shifted in entering the turn, saved ground but failed to rally. JET AWAY SUE pursued the leaders from inside after hopping just slightly at the start, lost ground into upper stretch, came out and was empty. SPECIAL RELATIVITY raced wide throughout going about five to seven wide through the bend and failed to respond.
