LANIER stalked the dueling pair, encroached upon them three wide into the turn, prompted three wide through the bend, took the lead near the quarter pole, and kicked away in the final furlong while drifting out. WHAT'S UP DUDE came away sharply but settled back to track in range of the pace outside down the backstretch and four wide on the turn, continued three to four wide in the lane and rallied well in the final furlong to prove best of the rest. NUN THE LESS chased the pace two wide down the backstretch and three wide on the turn, went to a drive near the quarter pole, found his best stride in the final furlong, proved no match for the winner, and lost the place late. SIR ANTHONY settled near the rear two wide down the backstretch, improved two wide into the turn, continued in the three path between horses around the bend, made a mild inside rally in the lane but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. REVVED UP settled at the rear, continued unhurried in the three path on the turn, and rallied belatedly through horses in the lane. RICHIESINTHEHOUSE sent to the front, dueled inside of GONEGHOST down the backstretch and into the turn, continued to battle inside of LANIER once headed by that foe near the quarter pole, but faded in the final furlong. GONEGHOST was placed on the lead, dueled outside of RICHIESINTHEHOUSE down the backstretch and into the turn, vied between that foe and LANIER around the bend, and came up empty from the quarter pole. ECKERSLEY settled three wide near the rear down the backstretch and into the turn, and had no response in the six path on the turn. MACHTREE settled four wide in the rear group down the backstretch, raced in the six path in the rear flight around the turn, and had no rally. GITA'S LAD chased the pace inside, hugged the rail through the turn and while under a drive into the lane, came up empty and was eased.
