1 1/8 MILES. (1.452) PETER PAN S. Grade III. Purse \$300,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nominations; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$120,000 at a mile or over in 2019 allowed 3 lbs.; of a Sweepstake other than state-bred at a mile or over or three races allowed 5 lbs.; of two races allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and state-bred allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 27, 2019 with 16 Nominations.

GLOBAL CAMPAIGN chased three then two wide in closest aim of the leader, began to advance on that rival midway on the turn and took over command at the five-sixteenths placed to light coaxing, spun just off the inside for home set down for the drive, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat and held safe to prevail. SIR WINSTON saved ground growing detached at the tail of the field unhurried, came under coaxing two to three wide at the five-sixteenths, went three wide at the quarter pole before swinging out six wide straightened away for home, drifted out two paths before offering up a good finish to close in with a rush late but ultimately could not get to the aforementioned foe before the finish. INTREPID HEART stumbled at the start then got bumped by FEDERAL CASE who broke inwards, chased just off the inside down the backstretch, came under coaxing at the nine-sixteenths and tipped four wide through the turn, swung five wide into upper stretch, drifted in straightened away and weakened while passing a pair of tiring rivals to secure the show honors. FINAL JEOPARDY three to four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a near sided stick and shied out near the eighth pole, then weakened through to the finish. FEDERAL CASE broke in at the start bumping INTREPID HEART before being hustled to the front, showed the way in hand just off the inside through solid splits, tucked inside through the turn, came under a ride at the three-eighths facing direct pressure for the initial time by the eventual winner, yielded the front five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch and weakened.
