

1 3/8 MILES. (Inner Turf) (2.10') MAN 'O' WAR S. Grade I. Purse \$700,000 INNER TURF FOR FOUR-YEAR- OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$700 which should accompany the nomination. \$5,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$5,250 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,500 in addition to the entry and starting fees can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided \$375,000 to the winner, \$130,000 to second, \$70,000 to third, \$46,000 to fourth, \$30,000 to fifth, \$20,000 to sixth, \$16,000 to seventh and \$13,000 to eighth. Weights, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade/Group I race at a mile or over in 2018-19 allowed 3 lbs.; of a Grade/Group II race at a mile or over in 2018-19 allowed 5 lbs.; of a Grade/Group III race at a mile or over in 2018-19 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, April 27, 2019 with 23 Nominations. (Rail at 9 feet).

CHANNEL MAKER forwardly placed just off the inside among the main flight in behind the top pair and then solely the spurting leader, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, advanced into closest striking range swinging three wide into upper stretch, rallied with a good kick to issue a challenge through the final furlong collaring the front inside the sixteenth marker with a rallying pair behind him, dug in to prevail by a stout neck at the wire. ARKLOW inside early on the initial time past the stands, raced two to three wide in pursuit from the tail of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to close in tandem with MAGIC WAND to his inside and missed at the finish while up for the place honors. MAGIC WAND (IRE) saved ground near the rear of the field, remained patiently handled riding the rail through the far turn, angled out four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, closed well in concert with the aforementioned foe to her outside to be up for the show honors in the shadow of the wire. HUNTING HORN (IRE) coaxed from the gate, established the front and showed the way a bit keen early on until given some rein to work with before settling into a comfortable rhythm along the inside into the backstretch, took a breather before widening away down the backstretch into the far turn by midway, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch, dug in under a drive through the stretch under growing threat from a trio inside the final eighth, got collared inside the final sixteenth while clear for the last major share. EPICAL tracked the leader two to three wide in closest aim early on isolated between that rival and the main flight in behind, remained patiently handled until placed to coaxing three furlongs from home as the leader widened away and the rest of the field began to latch on his hindquarters, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on the same pace to the finish getting outkicked in the final eighth. FOCUS GROUP settled unhurried just off the inside near the rear of the field to the outside of MAGIC WAND, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no response. ZULU ALPHA two to three wide past the stands the first time and through the opening bend, took to the four path down the backstretch and into the far turn, came under urging at the three-eighths, went five wide into upper stretch and offered no response. VILLAGE KING (ARG) two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, got coaxed along fading three furlongs from home, angled seven wide into upper stretch and weakened. KULIN ROCK three wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide from mid pack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, faded to the tail of the field through the far turn, swung eight wide for home and made no impact.
